- Remember that not all internal contacts or referrals are valuable. Make sure that your contact has a good reputation in the company first.
- It would be better not to name your contact/referral, unless the interviewer specifically asked for it.
- If you found out about it through recruiters, headhunters, online job postings, or other anonymous sources, try to connect the dots and explain the process, while heavily emphasizing that the job is a perfect match for you.
- Put more effort in answering this and think through your response carefully.
